I think of a number, then halve it.
The answer is 9 .
What was my number?
There are 16 plums.
8 children share them equally.
How many plums does each child have?
Two people have 8 cakes each. How many cakes have they altogether?
One person gives 2 cakes to the other. How many cakes does each one have now?

7 people are on a bus.
8 more get on and 3 get off.
How many people are on the bus now?

There are 25 bean bags.
Catherine takes 11 and Ian takes 9.
How many bean bags are left?

There are 2 red buttons and 4 blue buttons on a card of buttons.
How many buttons are there on 10 cards?
